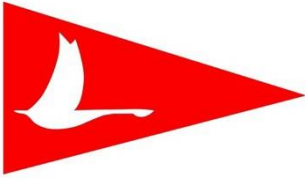


CYC OPEN FOR SUMMER REGATTA

NOTICE OF RACE (NoR)

1 RULES

The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 1700hrs on August 6th at the CYC.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The official notice board is located on the exterior west side of the change room building.
- 3.2 [DP] From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all classes.
- 4.2 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.3 Five or more boats of the same class registered by the August 7th at 0855 hrs will be scored as a fleet. All other boats will be scored using the current wind adjusted Portsmouth handicapping system.

VENUE

Racing will take place on the waters of Chestermere Lake, Alberta.

COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be either Windward/Leeward or Triangle/Sausage with a Hollywood Finish.

PENALTY SYSTEM

For the 29er class RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

SCORING

10.1

ONE race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.2

(a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

BERTHING

[DP] Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while in the boat park.

RISK STATEMENT

RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.
